An Act to amend the Law relative to the Inspection of Weights and Measures in Lower Canada.

WHEREAS the Laws now in force in Preamble.
Lower Canada, with respect to the appointment and duties of Inspectors of Weights and Measures, are found to require amendment: Be it therefore enacted, &c.

Reign of King George the Third, and intituled "*An Act for the better regulating the Weights and Measures of the Province,*" and so much of the said Act as authorizes any other person than the Revenue District Inspectors hereinafter to perform the duty of regulating, adjusting, stamping and marking Beams, Weights and Measures in Lower Canada, or as may be in any way inconsistent with the provisions of this Act, shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

II. And be it enacted, That the Clerk of Standards to be kept by the Clerk of the Legislative Assembly.
the Legislative Assembly for the time being shall have the custody of the standard Weights and Measures in the said Act directed to be kept in the custody of the Clerk of the Assembly of Lower Canada, and shall perform all the duties by the said Act assigned to the officer last mentioned: and if any of the standard Weights or Measures or of the Beams or Scales in the said Act directed to be kept in the custody of the said Clerk shall be found wanting, the Governor of this Province may cause others to be imported at the public cost, and placed in the custody
