In incorporated villages there shall be elected a Reeve and four Nomination Councillors, or if the village be entitled to a Deputy Reeve, then there and election 5 shall be elected a Reeve, Deputy Reeve, and three Councillors, and the Councillors nomination and election of such Reeve and Councillors, or Reeve, in Villages. Deputy Reeve, and Councillors, as the case may be, shall be conducted in the same manner as is now provided for the election of councillors in incorporated villages.
