And each returning officer before acting as such shall take and subscribe the oath and be subject to the penalties required and imposed by the eighteenth section of the Act passed in twelfth year of Her Majesty's Reign, intituled "*An Act to repeal certain Acts therein mentioned, and to amend, consolidate and reduce into one Act the several statutory provisions now in force for the regulation of Elections of Members to represent the people of this Province in the Legislative Assembly thereof.*" 10 15
