

An Act respecting the Manitoba and North-western
Railway Company of Canada.

WHEREAS the Manitoba and North-western Railway Company of Canada has, by its petition, prayed that it be enacted as hereinafter set forth, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition: Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows : Preamble.

1. The Manitoba and North-western Railway Company of Canada may, within seven years after the passing of this Act, construct the railways authorized by section 9 of chapter 52 of the statutes of 1893 and by chapter 79 of the statutes of 1894; and if the said railways are not then completed the powers of construction conferred upon the said company by Parliament shall cease and be null and void as respects so much of the said railways as then remains uncompleted.
