The King, by Order in Council, may authorize the importing into Quebec, See, Bread, Flour, Live Stock, and Indian Coin,

provided they be imported conformable to fuch Order, by Britip Subjects in Britis Simps; otherwise to be forfeited.

Forfeitures may be feized by Commanders of Ships of Var, Sc. and recovered and applied as Forfeitures respecting the

Cuttoms.

King's most Excellent Wajesty, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Loids Spiritual and Composal, and Commons, in this pictent Parliament allembled, and by the Authority of the same, That it hall and may be lawful for His Majesty in Council, by Older of Olders to be issued and published, from Time to Time, to authorise, in case of Decesity, the bringing or importing of Bread, Flour, Indian Corn, and Live Stock, as well into the faid Province. as into all the Countries bordering on the Gulf of Saint Lawrence, and into the Juands within the faid Gulf, and also to the Coast of Labrador, for the then ensuing Season only, from any of the Territories belonging to the faid United States of America, for the Supply of the Persons employed in carrying on the faid Fisheries: Provided always, That fuch Bread, Mour, Indian Corn, and Live Stock, so authorised to be imported or brought, hall not be imported or brought, except in Conformity to fuch Rules, Regulations, and Recriftions as thall be specified in such Dider or Diders, and except by British Subjects, and in British-huilt Shivs owned by Wis Wajedy's Subjeds, and navigated according to Law, under the Penalty of the Forfeiture thereof, together with the Ship of Cleffel importing or bringing the same, and all her Guns, Kurniture, Ammunition, Tackle, and Apparcl.

II. And be it further enaded by the Authority aforesaid, That all and every the Goods of Commodities, and all Ships or Cellels forfeited by this Ad, thall and may be seized by the Commander or Commanders of any of His Hajetty's Ships of Mellels of War, of any Commissioned, Marrant, or Petty Dicer, specially authorized by him or them, cy by any Officer of Officers of his Wafelty's Cuftoms; and that every Fozfeiture and Penalty incurred by this Act, Hall and may respectively be sued for, prosecuted, and recovered, in such Courts, and by such and the like Mays, Means, and Methods, and the Produce thereof respectively disposed of and applied in such and the like Manner, and to such and the like Uses and Purpoles, as any forfeiture incurred by any Law respecting the Revenue of the Customs may now be fued for, prosecuted or recovered, disposed of and applied, either in this Kingdom, oz in any cf his Majesty's Dominions in North America, or the West Indies, respectively, as the Case may happen to be.
