	3-5-42		Overcast, rain showers in afternoon. Divine Services were held in the Recreation Hall. Flying in the afternoon only.		
	4-5-42		Showers in the morning. Clear in afternoon. Mr. Eldon Dummit of Lexington, Kentucky, President of the Optimist International Club, and other members of the Ottawa Optimist Club made a tour of the Station.		
	5-5-42		Fair, cold, showers. Physical Training and Drill parades were held by Training Wing in the afternoon.		
	6-5-42		Overcast. At 1610 hours, R122071 LAC Riordan, R.C. landed high in Harvard 2558 at Main Aerodrome, aircraft stalled, dropping and damaging starboard wing. Pilot uninjured. Airframe damaged slightly.
