In reply to your verbal enquiry of this date regarding mineral locations, A, B, C and D on Echo Lake, in the Garden River Indian Reserve, I beg leave to say that Letters Patent were issued on the 31st of December 1873 to Charlotte Hall for Location A; the gold and silver being reserved in the Patent. Letters Patent were issued on the 24th of July, 1874 to G. F. Austin for location C; gold and silver being reserved in the Patent. Letters Patent issued on the 18th of December 1873 to Hon. R. W. Scott for location B; gold and silver being reserved in the Patent. Letters Patent issued on the 16th March, 1881 to G. F. Austin for location D; no reservation of gold or silver being made in this Patent.
