



Sir,-

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 25th ultimo, inclosing an agreement between Thomas Folsen and the Rev. Oblate Fathers in connection with six acres and right of way on lot 24, Quinze front, Temiscamingue and in connection therewith beg to call attention to letter addressed you on the 20th of December, 1911, inclosing a surrender of six acres and a roadway applied for by the Oblate Fathers, and to ask you to be good enough to state what action was taken in this matter, and whether the Oblate Fathers have abandoned their proposed purchase of land on lot 25, Quinze front.
