MEETING OF PRIME MINISTERS

SUBJECTS FOR DISCUSSION AT MEETING OF PRIME MINISTERS

Note by the Secretaries

It has been agreed with Commonwealth Prime Ministers that the main subjects for discussion at the Meeting should be as follows:-

- (i) International relations, with particular reference to the Soviet Union.
- (ii) The future of Germany.
- (iii) Japanese problems and the future of the Pacific.
 - (iv) Commonwealth interest in collaboration with Western Europe.
 - (v) The general economic situation and the European Recovery Programme.
- (vi) The development of the economic resources of the Commonwealth.
- (vii) Defence questions.
- (viii) Machinery for consultation between Commonwealth Governments.
- 2. It is suggested that in addition, if Commonwealth Prime Ministers agree, the following items should be added to the list:-
 - (ix) Precedence of Commonwealth High Commissioners.
 - (x) Situation in South East Asia (Burma, Indonesia, Malaya).
