by seven hands of wampum that Col. P.  
Schuyler may be forthwith despatched from  
hence to Onondaga to be Present when  
the French make any proposition to them  
Thereupon the Comd resolved to send for  
Col. Schuyler and to communicate to him  
the desire of the five Nations

Col. Schuyler answered that seven hands  
of Wampum were from the five Nations  
to desire him to go to Onondaga by the  
first opportunity to His Robt Hunter Esq  
Guptn General & with a letter that he cannot  
resolve to go before he receives instructions  
from His for that purpose

The Comd. told the said three Messengers  
that the hands of Wampum they had  
with the message should be sent to him  
to thank them for their services there  
was given to each of them a shirt for  
the message & hands of wampum to  
carry to the five Nations  
ordered that a letter be written to His Comd  
relating to the above message and the  
shall be there included
