

SQUAMISH Indian Reserve,

19th November, 1946.

We, the undersigned, Chief and Councillors of the SQUAMISH Band of Indians owning the Reserve situated at NORTH VANCOUVER, in the VANCOUVER Indian Agency, in the Province of BRITISH COLUMBIA at a council summoned for the purpose, according to the rules of the Band, and held on the said Reserve, this 19th November day of November, A.D. 1946., in the presence of the Indian Agent for the said Reserve, representing thereat the Minister of Mines and Resources for the Dominion of Canada;

Do hereby for ourselves, and on behalf of the Indian owners of the said Reserve, request that a sum not exceeding Three Hundred forty-six (\$346.00) Dollars, be paid out of money standing to the credit of this Band, for the purpose of paying the cost of changing the location of a portion of the pipeline appurtenant to the domestic water supply system on Chekwelp Indian Reserve No.26, as estimated by the Dominion Water Power Bureau. It is further requested that future maintenance costs of the said system be paid from Band Funds as and when necessary.
