in the Province of Nova-Scotia; and that the Lands, Tenements, or Hereditaments, for which I claim a right to Vote, confilts of , and are situate, lying, and being, in and the fame hath or have not been made or granted to me traudulently on purpose to qualify me to give my Vote; and that I have not received, or had by myfelf or any perfon whatever in truft for me, or for my use and benefit, directly or indirectly, any fum or fums of money, office, place, or employment, gift, or reward, or any promife or fecurity for any money, office, employment or gift, in order to give my Vute at this Election, and that I have not before been Polled at this Election, and that the place of my abode is at

So help me God. Or if Quakers, the teft or affirmation to the fame effect; and all fraudulent conveyances of Land, for the purpose of multiplying Votes, or to qualify Voters at Elections, fubject to an agreement to re-convey the fame, shall be taken against the Grantors as free and abiolute, and all collateral fecurities for defeating fuch Eflate, shall be void ; and the perfon making fuch conveyances, or Voting by colour thereof, shall forfeit ten pounds to any perfon that will fue for the fame, in any Court of Record in this Province; one half part to the perfon or perfons, who shall profecute the fame to effect, and the other half to and for the use of the Poor of the County or Town concerned in such Election ; and if any Elector shall, being thereunto required, refuse or neglect to take the faid Oath, or to ing to take the affirth the effect thereof as aforefaid, that the Poll or Vote of fuch perfor neglecting or refuing, that be, and is hereby declared to be, null and void, and as fuch thall be rejected.

> II. And be it further enacted, That each perfon hereafter to be choich a Member of Affembly, and each Elector, at the time of giving his Vote in any Election, hereafter to be held in this Province, thall actually have an Income of Forty Shillings per annum, in Freehold Effate, or thall have, within the County or Town for which he thall Vote, or be Elected, in his own right; in fee fimple, a Dwelling Houfe, with the Ground on which the fame ftands. or One Hundred Acres of Land, whereof Five at least that be under cultivation ; fuch perfon or perfons poffeffing any one of the beforementioned interests, shalf be entitled to Vote, or be Elected for the County or Town wherein the fame shall be fituate. Provided always, that no perfon shall be entitled to Vote in any Election, to be hereafter held in this Province, or shall be eligible to serve as a Member of Assembly, who shall not have had the Grant, or Conveyance, under which he holds as aforefaid, registered fix months before the teft of the Writ, for holding the Election. Provided also, that nothing in this Ad contained, thall be construed to extend to any perfon or perfons, holding by defcent, or devise of the yearly value aforelaid.

111. And se it further endeled, That if any Candidate be queftioned as to his qualification by any Elector, at the commencement of the Poll, fuch Candidate thall flate to the Sheriff. or other Officer, where the Lands, Tenements, or Hereditaments do lie, whereby he makes out his qualification, declaring his having an actual Income of Forty Shillings per annum, in Freehold Eftate, or otherwile qualified as the Law directs, which flatement, and declaration of fuch Candidate, shall, by the Sheriff or other Officer, be marked down at the fame time in the Poll Book, and fuch Candidate, Shall, if required, take and fubfcribe the following Oath :
