KITE AS A LIFE-SAVER.

Could Be Seen By Castaways For Long Distance At Sea.

Mr. S. F. Cody, of London, considers that a boatload of shipwrecked persons who have a kite to fly are far more likely to be rescued than a kiteless boatload. He argues that a kiteless boatload. He has built a boat to exemplify his theory. It is an open three-tonner, with a length of twenty-one feet and a beam of six feet, and is driven by petrol.

Mr. Cody invited a number of ladies to step abboard and play the part of castaways on Crystal Palace Lake, and ten of them bravely responded. Away went the Lela up the lake at a rate of seven miles an hour, and at the right moment Mr. Cody unloosed a double-bodled, bat-shaped kite, six or seven feet long, which soared into the air to a height of about 200 yards. It floated there during the "voyage," and it could easily be understood how such an object out at sea would attract the attention of a passing vessel miles away.

Mr. Cody told an "Express" representative that if he could obtain the consent of the British Government he meant to give his idea a practical trial on the ocean.

"First of all I shall sail in the boat

"First of all I shall sall in the boat from the Isle of Wight to Blackpool, or the Isle of Wight to Brighton," he said, "and fly the kite to see how it attracts the attention of steamers.

"Then I shall take the Lela aboard some vessel sailing for South America, and after two days be cast adrift. I shall haul the kite, and keep it flying until I am picked up by some passing steamer, and then, after a day or so, repeat the experiment. So I shall go on until I reach South America.

"I intend to take ten days' provisions with me, and four kites. The latter can be rolled up into bundles about six feet long, and four inches thick. They can be flown to any height, according to the length of string available, and can be paid out by hand. About 30 pounds of cord will reach a quarter of a mile.

"My object is to prove that. Small life-boats cannot drift along for any length of time without being seen if they form a part of the equipment of every ocean-going steamer."


