FALKLAND ISLANDS

A Southern Outpost of the British Empire.

This group of islands, situated in the South Atlantic, at a distance of about 200 miles nearly due east of the Magellan Straits, forms an archipelago, consisting of two larger islands and about 50 smaller ones.

The community is fairly prosperous. The total population is some 2,300, of whom about 1,000 are concentrated in Port Stanley, the capital.

The sole industry of the colony is that of rearing sheep. Grass grows but scantily upon the past; but sheep do well, although an allowance has to be made for their own food.

Wool, tallow and sheepsheads are therefore, the principal exports of the colony and are the main source of revenue.

As regards climate the average winter temperature ranges between 40 degrees and 50 degrees Fahr., and that of summer between 45 degrees and 55 degrees.

Argentina's Claim. The pretensions of the government of the Argentine Republic to sovereignty over the Falkland Islands, though based upon a misconception of the facts, are taken so seriously by the average citizen of that country.

by Argentina and her dependencies were wrested from the Dominion of Spain. The fact that before that period Spain had acknowledged the sovereignty of Great Britain over the Falklands and that they were consequently not a dependency of the former Spanish colony is persistently disregarded.

It has always been the policy of the Argentine Government to preserve good relations with European countries and to avoid as far as possible contentious questions.

Argentina casts a jealous eye on the Falklands, which by their geographical situation are regarded as a proper adjunct to her continent.

The tenacity of the Argentine claim to the Falklands will be best understood from an outline of their history.

So far there has been no attempt at permanent occupation of the islands. In 1749 Lord Anson called the attention of the British Government to the desirability of establishing a settlement there.

Meantime, however, in 1764, a French adventurer named De Bougainville had established a small settlement at Port Louis, in East Falkland.
