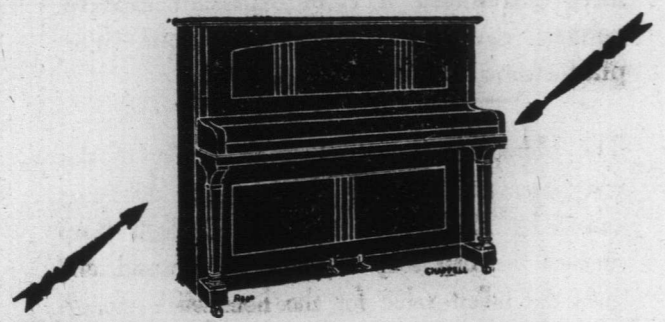


Methodist College, St. John's
