B then ships the purchase to A on approval and when A writes us that the pur-chase is satisfactory we forward amount to B less our commission. If the birds are not satisfactory A returns them to B and we return money to A less our commission.

Rules-1. All purchases must be sent on approval, buyer to pay charges each way unless otherwise arranged.

Our commission on sales up to \$20 is 50 cents. over \$20 21/2 per cent. If no sale is made we return money less same amount.

Packing must be supplied free of charge by seller unless otherwise arranged.
