being French women, whose children are in attendance at our school. District visiting has been somewhat difficult in the homes of those preparing to move. I have visited with much satisfaction a number of sick people, which afforded me an opportunity of reading the Scriptures and talking to them of salvation. One woman, who has been ill for four years, said her bodily strength was almost gone, but her spiritual strength was strong, and her faith in God steadfast. She was so thankful for the time I had spent with her, urging me to return, and expressing her resignation to God's will. The Sunday services are pretty well attended, eighteen members having been added to the Church this year. Last evening we had a good fellowship meeting, the Spirit of the Lord being present.
