CURE FOR EARACHE.-Cotton wool, wet with camphor, or paregoric and sweet oil, warm, and the ear bandaged will give relief.

LITTLE cakes of cheese are made of flour, butter and grated cheese, pepper and salt well mixed together, with the yolks of one or more eggs, according to quantity of cheese and flour, etc., baked in well buttered tiny cake pans, turned out and served hot.

HASTY PUDDING.—Mix two cups of flour with one cup of cold milk; have ready one pint of boiling milk, and stir in gradually; pour back into a thick vessel on the stove, and stir until it boils; pour into a deep dish, and surve with polyses or butter and sugar. and serve with molasses or butter and sugar.

A THREE MINUTES' PUDDING. -- Take A THREE MINUTES PUDDING, -- Take one tablespoonful of four and one of sugar, a teaspoonful of baking powder, and one egg. Place the mixture in a small long dripping tin, and take lightly. When removed from the tin, spread either stewed apples or preserved fruit over it, and roll it up like a bolster. It is described as a three minutes' pudding. pudding.

BOILED MACKEREL.—After cleaning the fish, place it in a fish kettle, just cover it with cold water and a gill of vinegar, or with half water and half white wine; season with three or four sprigs of parsley, one of thyme, a bay leaf, one clove, one onion, half a carrot in slices, two cloves of garlic, salt, pepper, and perhaps a little tarragon, if the latter is at hand. Set on the fire and boil gently till done. Dish the fish and serve it warm, with a caper or anchovy sauce.

BREAD CAKE. One pint bowl of dough as it is ready to mould into bread, four eggs beaten separately, one cup of hutter, two cups of white sugar, one tablespoonful of cinnamon, one nutmeg, one-half teaspoonful of soda, one pint bowl of stoned raisins. Mix by hand. Put the dough into a large bowl. First work in the butter well, then the sugar and spice, next the yolks and then the whites of the eggs, then the soda dissolved in a little warm water, lastly the raisins. Let it rise after putting in pans. Bake about as long as bread. This quantity makes two loaves. loaves.

SLICED TOMATOES AND ONION PICKLES. Slice one peck of green tomatoes and eight large onions; strew over them a coffee cup of salt-mix and let stand over night. Next morning drain and put over the fire in a preserving kettle, with a quart of vinegar and two of water. When at boiling heat simmer half-an-hour; drain and cover with following hot preparation: Take four quarts of vinegar, add to it two pounds of white sugar, half-apound of white mustard seed, two table-spoonfuls each of ground cloves, cinnamon, allspice and mustard. This mixture should boil fifteen minutes before pouring over the pickle. SLICED TOMATOES AND ONION PICKLES.

BEEF ROLL. Chop two pounds of lean beef very sine; chop and pound in a mortar half-a-pound of bacon and mix it with the beef. Season it with pepper and salt, a small nutmeg, the grated rind of a lemon, the juice of a quarter of it, a heaping teaspoonful of parsley, minced sine, or it can be seasoned with an additional teaspoonful of onion; or if no onion or parsley is at hand, with summer-savory and thyme. Bind all these together with two eggs, and form them into a roll; surround the roll with buttered paper, which tie securely around it; then cover it with a paste made of slour and water; bake two hours; remove the paper and crust; serve it hot with tomato sauce or brown gravy. This may be made with raw or under-dressed meat. If the meat is not raw but underdressed, surround the roll with pie crust; bake and serve with tomato sauce, or crust; bake and serve with tomato sauce, any of the brown sauces.
