In Canada a fairly good crop is estimated.

Last spring spraying was more generally and scientifically practiced than ever before. The result of this is that this year's apples are less worm eaten and are larger and finer in con sequence. One thing seems assured, the crop of 1894 will be heavier and better than that of 1893. An average crop in the Province of Ontario is accounted to be 3,000,000 tarrels, 10 per cent of which are summer apples, 30 per cent fall and 60 per cent winter.

The United States last year had a poor crop and afforded Canada a ready market at good prices. This year the conditions are the opposite. The crop in New England will be very large, and much the same may be said of that in the States west of the Mississippi. Michigan and Iowa will have a fair crop, while in Ohio, Indiana and New York the yield will be smaller than usual-Exchange,
