MONTREAL PAROCHIAL SCHOOL.

UNDER THE PATRONAGE OF THE LORD BISHOP OF QUEBEC.

THE REV. J. BETHUNE begs to inform the public that this Institution has been open since the Middle of May.

The School, as it regards the object and general system of the Institution, will be under the joint control of the LORD BISHOP OF THE DIOCESE and the RECTOR OF THE PARISH, the latter of whom will have the superintendance and direction as it regards the immediate management of its affairs and the particular system of instruction to be pursued. But, as it regards the immediate teaching and management of the Pupils, it will be under the control of the principal Teacher, who will always be a Clergyman of the church of England.—The strictest attention will be paid to discipline and the morals of the Children.

Some portion of time will be set apart for Religious Instruction, either on Sundays or other days, as may be found most expedient.

The Terms of Tuition will be

For each pupil, in English Reading, Writing and Grammar.....	45	0	per Ann.
Ditto, in Arithmetic, Geography and Book-keeping.....	7	10	
Ditto, in the Classics, Mathematics, or other Branches usually taught at the same time.....	10	0	

For French, if required, the French Master's fee only will be charged.

The Tuition fee will be payable, during the first year, quarterly in advance.

Books and Stationary will be imported from England, and will be furnished to Pupils at cost and charges.

A few pupils can be accommodated in a genteel private family, at £26 per annum, payable quarterly in advance, for board, washing and mending, each pupil furnishing his bed, bedding and towels.
