- 6. During the course of the meeting a number of important questions were raised which will require further study and which will form part of the agenda for the next meeting. Among these were:
 - a) On manufacturing, the Canadian side proposed a goal to increase Canadian exports of manufactured goods to Japan to a \$1 billion level by 1985. The Japanese delegation agreed that efforts would be made towards such a target.
 - b) The two delegations agreed that the Japanese side would be prepared to discuss at the next meeting the prospects for joint ventures in the aerospace sector.
 - c) The Japanese side raised the matter of employment authorization visas and the requirement that they be renewed annually. The Canadian side undertook to raise this with the appropriate ministry in Ottawa.
 - d) On energy it was agreed that there should be further study on the question of Japanese access to a share of the production arising from projects in which there was Japanese investment.
 - e) The Japanese side undertook to examine further their financing practices in relation to the Canadian fishing industry.
