APPOINTMENTS TO THE CANADIAN COMMERCIAL CORPORATION

International Trade Minister John C. Crosbie announced today the appointment of two members of the Board of Directors of the Canadian Commercial Corporation.

Gordon Walker practises law in London and Toronto, Ontario. He served as an M.P.P. for 12 years which included 7 years in the Ontario Cabinet. He held a number of portfolios including Industry and Trade, and Consumer and Commercial Relations. A previous Director of the Ontario Chamber of Commerce, Mr. Walker has been involved with a number of charitable and business organizations.

W. David Angus is a senior partner with Stikeman, Elliott, of Montreal, Quebec. He is active in a number of professional organizations, including the Canadian Maritime Law Association of which he is currently President. He is Governor of the International Maritime Organization - International Maritime Law Institute in Malta, a member of the Canadian Board of Marine Underwriters, and past Chairman of the Average Adjusters Association of Canada. Mr. Angus is also a director of a number of Canadian business corporations and charitable organizations.

The Canadian Commercial Corporation is a federal Crown Corporation which reports to the Minister for International Trade and which in 1989-90 signed \$774 million in export sales on behalf of Canadian exporters.
