shall be furnished for faithful performance of duty. He must sign all cheques for payment of accounts passed by the Finance Committee, and endorse cheques, orders, etc., in the name of the Club for deposit. He must issue notices to all members of the Clnb, and the various Committees as provided for in by-laws.

Letters concerning the business of the Club may be dictated to the Secretary-Treasurer in his office by the President, the Hon. Treasurer, the Hon. Secretary, and the members of the Federal or Local Ministry.

UNIFORM OF EMPLOYEES.

A suitable uniform, to be worn by employees of the Club, shall be decided upon by the House Committee.
