Section II. That every Pilot, to distinguish his boat and sails, Every Pilot to take a number shall take a number from the Clerk of the Trinity House of Quefrom the Clerk kec, who shall enter in a Register the name of such Pilot, with his distinguishing number opposite, and any Pilot who shall mark or paint, or cause to be marked or painted on his boat, or on any oat and sails of the sails thereof, any number other than the number which he

shall have received from the Clerk of this Corporation, shall incur a penalty not exceeding Ten Pounds Currency.

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III. That any Pilot who shall stop or anchor any merchant ship alongside the moorings of Her Majesty ships, (except in case of extreme necessity), shall incur a penalty not exceeding Ten Pounds Currency.

IV. That any Pilot who shall take charge of any ship or vessel as a Pilot, otherwise than his Branch empowers him, shall incur a penalty not exceeding Ten Pounds Currency.
