In the preceding form blank space is left where the name of the invited person must be written. Here is another form which is very popular:

Mr. and Mrs. Charles E. Evans

request your presence at the marriage of their daughter

Dorothy May.

to

Mr. Ernest A. Morrison, On Wednesday evening, June thirteenth, Nineteen hundred and three, at eight o'clock, First Baptist Church, Montreal.

These two forms are also correct for a home wedding by omitting the name of the church and inserting the street address.

It is also correct to say :

request the pleasure of your company

instead of

request your presence

should you prefer it that way.
