The applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-Agency for the district. Entry by proxy may be made at any agency, on certain conditions, by lather, mother, son, daughter. brother or sister of intending homesteader. Dutles—Six months' residence upon and cutivation of the land in each of in certain districts a homesteader in good standing may pre-empt a quarter-stead or pre-emption six months in each of six years from date of homestead entry (including the time required to earn homestead patent) and cultivate inty acres extra.
