REICH DEAL ENEMY TO OBTAIN DAMAGING BLOWS NEAR VERDUN
ACHIEVE IMPORTANT RESULTS

On the French Front in France, Monday, March 18.—The center of military interest during the past few days has centered on the Champagne to the vicinity of Verdun, where both the French and the Germans have broken into marked activity.

ALLIES SMASH UP GERMAN DEFENCES IN CHEPPY WOOD AND MALANCOURT, IN MEUSE REGION—GERMAN ATTEMPTS PRODUCE INSIGNIFICANT EFFECTS.

In the Verdun region the correspondents watched the execution of two trench raids on a large scale carried out by the French on Saturday evening and at dawn on Sunday, the results of which exceeded all expectations. Within 12 hours the French had penetrated the remarkably strong systems of German trenches in both Cheppy Wood and Malancourt Wood to a depth at some points of more than a quarter of a mile.
