

When the work is done mounding and posting should be in accordance with the present practice of the Department of the Interior, but with regard to the posts in the centre of the Sections, as this would involve no small amount of additional work and outlay, its consideration should be reserved until the other part of the work is under weigh.

The subdivision of hay lands at the north end of the Reserve which are to be held as common ~~xxx~~ is not asked for, but it is a question whether time and funds permitting it might not be well to subdivide them also.
