BY-LAW XVII—SUSPENSION OF BY-LAWS.

Any By-law may be suspended by a three-fourths vote at any regular meeting, for that meeting only.

BY-LAW XVIII.

No member shall be entitled to vote on any question or participate in the discussion or transactions of the Association who has not paid his annual dues.

BY-LAW XIX.

In case of the absence of the President and Vice-President, the Association shall appoint a President *pro tem*.

BY-LAW XX.

No person shall be permitted to occupy the time or engage the attention of the meeting but members, delegates or guests invited to take part in the discussion; and no member is to occupy the floor in any discussion for a longer time than ten minutes, nor shall he have the privilege of speaking more than once on any question under consideration, except in explanation or by permission of the chair.
