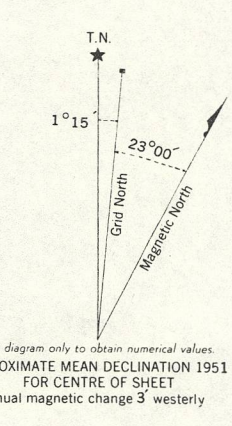

POINT Triangulation Station	
FOR STANDARD MILITARY GRID REFERENCE	
East	North
Take West edge of square in which point lies, and read the figure printed opposite this line on North or South margin or on the line itself on the face of the map. (Estimate north or Southward.)	Take South edge of square in which point lies, and read the figure printed opposite this line on East or West margin or on the line itself on the face of the map. (Estimate north or Southward.)

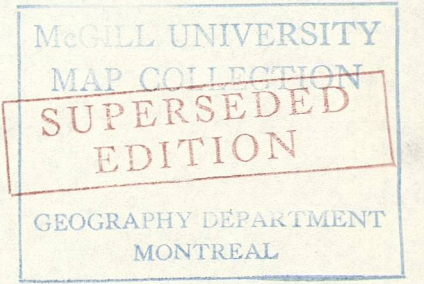
