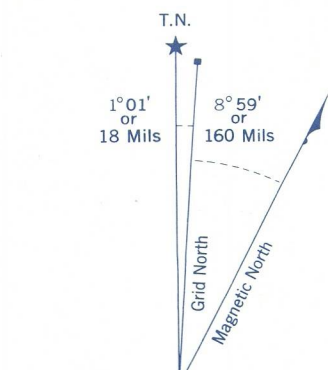

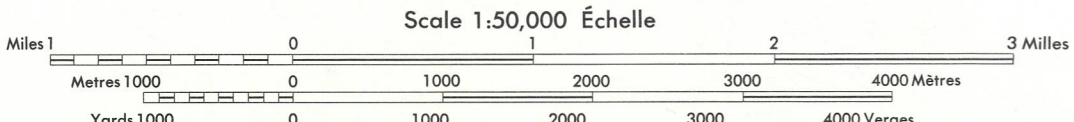

EXAMPLE OF METHOD USED TO OBTAIN REFERENCE TO NEAREST 100 METRES THE FOLLOWING GRID REFERENCE IS A SIMPLE ONE AND DOES NOT REFER TO A POINT ON THIS MAP	
99 98 97	95 96 97 98
REFERENCE POINT	CHELURCH (as above)
EASTING: Read number on grid line immediately to left of point Estimate tenths of a square from this line eastward to point	97 975
NORTHING: Read number on grid line immediately below point Estimate tenths of a square from this line northward to point	98 984
EXAMPLE MILITARY GRID REFERENCE 975084	
Nearest square grid reference 100,000 metres (about 63 miles)
