—The number of tons of ice cut in Maine during the past winter exceed any previous harvest by 1,500,000 tons, showing a grand total of 3,093,400 tons, of which 1,441,200 tons is on the Kennebec river, 506,300 on the Penobeoot, 42, 300 tons on the Cathance, and 839,800 along the coast and interior ponds, also 263,800 tons shipped direct from ponds by vessels. Ice was cut in 100 different towns and cities in the state and is now stored in 279 ice houses. About 19,000 men and 4,620 horses were at work.


