IL MEURT EN BON CHRETIEN

APRES AVOIR ETE UN ENEMI ACCARNE DE LA FOL

Paris, 18.—M. Louis Lacombe, officier de la Légion d'honneur, ancien député de l'Aveyron, m'a pendant plus de quarante ans de la ville de Rodez, vient de mourir à l'âge de 74 ans. Le défunt a été, durant près d'un demi siècle le chef incontesté du parti radical dans l'Aveyron. Il y mena des luttes électorales violentes dont on conservera longtemps le souvenir.

Comme maire de Rodez, il supprima les processions et soutint contre les "congrégations et enseignes" est libre de la lutte à outrance. Comme député, il prit part à l'élaboration des lois contre les Congrégations et de celle sur la séparation de l'Eglise et de l'Etat.

C'est à son initiative que furent décidés les inventaires destinés à assurer sous un faux prétexte la mainmise de l'Etat sur les biens de l'Eglise. Aussi l'avait-on surnommé le "père des inventaires".

Depuis deux ans il vivait dans la retraite nécessitée par ses infirmités, et surtout par une aphasic peu près complète, qui lui avait cependant laissé toute lucidité d'esprit, ce qui lui a permis un retour sur lui-même, aux traditions de sa famille, aux principes reçus dans son enfance chez les Jésuites. Bien avant sa mort, il a abjuré la Franc-Maçonnerie, à laquelle il avait appartenu, et est mort dans les sentiments chrétiens, après avoir reçu les derniers sacrements.

Budapest, 16.—Son Eminence le cardinal Czernoch, archevêque de Gran, primat of Hongrie qui fut l'un des princes de l'Eglise au Congrès eucharistique de Chicago est à la dernre extrémité. Il était né à Szakoloza, diocèse de Gran, le 18 juin 1852. Il étudia à Vienne et à Rome. Ordonné prêtre le 18 novembre 1874, il fut curé et chanoine de l'église métropolitaine de Gran, député au parlement hongrois, protonotaire apostolique le 15 avril 1907, élu évêque de Csanad le 16 février 1908, transféré à Kalocsa le 20 avril 1911, promu à Gras et primat de Hongrie le 13 décembre 1912, succédant au cardinal Vasvary démissionnaire. Crée cardinal-prêtre le 25 mai 1914, il reçut le 6 juillet suivant des mains de l'archidiacre héritier François Ferdinand, et le chapeau, le 8 septembre suivant avec le titre de St-Eusebe, dont il prit possession par procuration le 21 septembre suivant. C'est lui qui couronna l'empereur Charles de Habsbourg roi de Hongrie le 31 décembre 1914.
