

Ottawa, August 6, 1931.


Sir:

I have your letter of the 29th ultimo, regarding the repairs required to the plaster in various parts of the building at the Onion Lake R. C. Indian Residential School. In this connection I have to say that the Department will approve of you arranging to have the repairs to this plaster carried out. It is noted you estimate the cost to be approximately \$25. After the repairs have been completed, please forward a certified account, in duplicate, covering the expenditure incurred.

Relative to the request of the Reverend Principal to have burlap installed throughout the halls and stairways, I have to say that we have no funds available for this purpose, and this work will have to stand over for the present.
