At the last meeting of the Theological Students' Fund Committee, the following resolution was adopted, and ordered to be published in the *Church Herald* and *Church Chronicle*:—

*Resolved*, "That inasmuch as the object for which the Theological Students' Fund was established, and is kept up, is to assist young men desiring to study for Holy Orders, whose circumstances require pecuniary assistance to enable them to pursue such studies; it be a standing rule of the Committee of this Fund, that no aid be granted out of said Fund to any applicant, unless his circumstances be shewn to the satisfaction of the Committee to be such as render it necessary that aid be extended to him; and that any such application be in all cases supported by a letter from the clergyman of the parish in which he resides."
