GENERAL.

ARTICLE 1.—Elections to office shall be by ballot.

ARTICLE 2.—No Article of these By-laws shall be altered except at a Regular Meeting of the Association.

Sec. 1.—Notice of such proposed alteration shall have been given at a previous meeting.

ARTICLE 3.—No pamphlet, circular, letter, or original or selected matter, shall be put forth apparently in the name or with the sanction of this Association, by any member, until the same has been submitted to and approved by a committee appointed for that purpose by the President.

Sec. 1.—Said committee shall consist of three members of the Executive Committee.

ARTICLE 4.—The badge of this Association shall be a narrow ribbon of a primrose yellow colour.

Sec. 1.—Members shall wear the badge on all suitable occasions, particularly at public meetings called by the Association.

ARTICLE 5.—All Regular Meetings of this Association shall be opened with prayer and closed with the Doxology.
