

ARSENAULT, *Hon. JOSEPH OCTAVE, J.P.* (*Prince, 3rd Dist.*)

Of Acadian descent. B. in P.E.I., 5 Augt., 1828, Ed. there. M., Apl., 1861, Miss Gaudet, also of Acadian descent. Apptd. a mem. of the Ex. Council, 25 July, 1873. First returned to Parl., for present seat, 1867; re-elected in 1870, in 1872, and again in 1873. A Conservative.—*Edmont Bay.*

BEER, *Lieut.-Col. Hon. HENRY.* (*Queens, 3rd Dist.*)

A merchant. Has sat in the Ex. Council. Is Col. of the Queens County Regt., V.M. A Liberal. —*Southport.*

BRECHEN, *Hon. FREDERICK DE ST. CROIX, Q.C.* (*Charlottetown.*)

S. of the Hon. John Brechen, who was a mem. of the Ex. and Legislative Councils of P.E.I. for many years before the introduction of Responsible Govt. B. at Charlottetown, 9 Dec., 1828 Ed. at the Central Academy. M., Sept., 1858, at St. John, N.B., Helen L. B., dau. of the late Capt. Emslie of the 83rd Regt. Called to the Bar, P.E.I., 1852. Created a Q.C., 1872. A mem. of the law firm of Haviland & Brechen. Was a mem. of Ex. Council and Attorney and Advocate-Genl., from Apl., 1859 to Jan., 1863; and from Sept., 1870 to
