S. of Wm. Kidston, Esq., a merchant of Glasgow, Scot. B. in Halifax, N. S., 1815. Ed. in Glasgow, Scot. M. the relict of Lieut. James Duffus, of the Royal Navy, and sister of the late Hon. Alex. McDougall, M. L. C. A merchant. Is Custos of Victoria, and Major Victoria Reserve Militia. Has been County Treasurer. KIRK, Lt.-Col. JOHN ANGUS, *J. P.* [*Guysborough.*]

Grands. of William Kirk, formerly of the British Army, who served during the Am. revolutionary war, and afterwards settled in N. S. B. at Glenelg, N. S., 1 March, 1837. Ed. at St. François Xavier College, Antigonish. M., 1864, Sarah Susannah, dau. of Mr. Timothy McLean. Is Lieut.-Col. 5th Guysborough Regt. of Militia.
