

In the statement of expenditure the following services have not been included as they are of a national character and not directly connected with the administration of natural resources:

Part of Civil Government salaries and contingencies, being those services that are not directly connected with the administration of natural resources, amounting roughly to one-third of the whole expenditure under the headings of Civil Government	6,180,037 (estimated)

The following services are included in the statement of expenditure:

Civil Government - about two-thirds of the total expenditure is estimated to be chargeable to the administration of natural resources.
 Dominion Lands Salaries and Contingencies
 Dominion Lands Surveys
 Protection of Timber
 Water Power
 Irrigation and Drainage
 Cost of Litigation
 Cost of Seed Grain Administration
 Miscellaneous.

The cost of administration of seed grain and relief has been included in the reckoning of expenditure as loans for this purposes were made to settlers in the Prairie provinces only.

The amount of the loans, however, have not been included, they being advances to be repaid to the Department; nor have the payments thereon been included as revenue.

On the basis of the number of immigrants destined to the province of Alberta the expenditure under immigration with regard to that province is estimated to be \$5,231,337.
