In the statement of expenditure the following services have not been included as they are of a national character and not directly connected with the administration of natural resources:

Dominion Lands Salaries and Contingencies

Dominion Lands Surveys

Protection of Timber

Water Power

Irrigation and Drainage

Cost of Litigation

Cost of Seed Grain Administration

Miscellaneous.

The cost of administration of seed grain and relief has been included in the reckoning of expenditure as leans for this purposes were made to settlers in the Prairie provinces only.

The amount of the leans, however, have not been included, they being advances to be repaid to the Department; nor have the payments thereon been included as revenue.

On the basis of the number of immigrants destined to the province of Alberta the expenditure under immigration with regard to that province is estimated to be \$3.231.337.
