

or to enforce Sunday or holiday observance as a matter of criminal law, or to deal with holidays in some peculiar Dominion aspect as being, for example, bank holidays) Parliament legislates respecting holidays only under the residuary power relating to peace, order and good government and not to the exclusion of the powers conferred upon the provinces by section 92 of the B. N. A. Act.
