Company to meet an authorized valuator from the Department on the lands, and that in view of this and in order to facilitate matters that it might be advisable for these valuators to meet in the first instance. If you share this view would you be good enough to ascertain from the Company at what date their valuator could meet the officer from the Department at Gaughnawage and advise the Department accordingly. I may say that the 12th of May would be a suitable date for the Department's officer.
