



Ottawa, May 22nd., 1917.

Sir,-

Referring to your letter of the 9th instant, I beg to say that the statement therein contained of amounts paid on the loan from band funds made to A. V. Logan is correct. The amount of loan which he received was \$422.74. He repaid \$135.69 as shown by you. In addition to this repayment, which has been credited to him, he is entitled to a credit of \$240.00 as there are four persons in his family, each of whom receives under the band loan system \$60.00. It will therefore be seen that the credit of \$135.69 and also the credit of \$240.00, or a total of \$375.69, leaves a balance of \$47.05 due by him.
