No. 110. Most Secret. My telegram of today Circular  
D 102.

It will be seen that Order in Council is drafted in  
its application to British ports by reference to Prize Court  
Rules at present in force under Order in Council of September  
2nd, copy of which was sent to you in my circular note No. 163,  
September 15th. It is hoped that His Majesty's Government in  
Canada will consider taking similar action such as would make  
it possible to deal in Canadian areas of control with any  
merchant vessel containing or suspected to contain German  
exports which have not been dealt with by control here.
