As it is understood that it is proposed by your Department to construct a thoroughfare through the Indian Residential School Reserve subdivision at Alert Bay between Park Street and Boundary Street running through lots numbered from 1 to 9 and leading to the local cemetery, I would request that you be good enough to submit a formal application together with tracing, blue prints and description so that the matter can be taken up in due course with the Department. In the meantime I have asked the Indian Agent to keep in touch with your District Engineer in connection with this matter.
