

Sho-ock.

Situated between the 35 and 36 Mile
Post from Yale on the Yale-Cariboo
Wagon Road, consists of the Old Reserve
(see map) and an extension easterly of about
100 acres.

* 50 inches of water from any available
sources of water supply.

On the left bank of the Fraser at the 37 and
38 mile posts from Yale on the Yale-Cariboo
Wagon Road.

* 200 inches of water from any available
sources of water supply.

directly opposite to the 36 mile post Reserve.

* 200 inches of water from any available sources
of water supply and particularly from a stream
called Chant-chuck w. flowing into the Fraser a
little above the Reserve, to which the Indians
are to have a prior right.

An old Reserve on the left bank of the
Fraser River near the 102 mile post from Yale
on the Yale-Cariboo wagon road.

* 50 inches of water from any available
sources of water supply particularly from the
Chant-chuck stream immediately south of
the Reserve and from the surplus water
