

- 40 *Will* followed by an infinitive has sometimes the meaning of *vouloir*.

Ex. : I will have that.

Je veux cela.

I will speak.

Je veux parler.

He will have me go there.

Il veut que j'aille là.

Falloir

- 10 *Falloir* is translated by *must* or *ought*.

Il me faut travailler.

Jè dois travailler.

I must work.

- 20 *Il me faut*, *il nous faut*, *il leur faut*

I want, we want, they want.

I want money.

Il me faut de l'argent.

- 30 *S'en falloir de beaucoup*—to be far from.

Ex. : *Il s'en faut de beaucoup que la somme soit complète.*

The sum is far from being complete.

- 40 *Il faut*, *il fallait* followed by a direct object are translated by *it requires*, *it required*.

Ex. : *Il faut du temps pour aller là.*

It requires time to go there.

Attendre

There are two verbs in English to translate the French *Attendre*. They are *to expect* and *to wait*.
