

23°. No Member shall, on any pretence or in any manner whatsoever, receive any profit, salary, or emolument, from the funds of the Club; nor shall any Member give any money or gratuity to any of the servants of the establishment, upon any pretence whatsoever: it being understood that this rule is not intended to preclude any Member of the Club from selling property or goods, or stocks or other money securities, to the Club, or buying any of the same from the Club.

24°. The games of Piquet and Pool are permitted to be played for limited stakes. The limits of stakes to be fixed by the Committee.

25°. No Member is on any account to bring a dog into the Club-House.

26°. Any Article of this Constitution may be altered, amended or suspended for any length of time, by consent of two-thirds of the Members present at any Meeting specially convened for that purpose; provided such alteration, amendment or suspension shall have been specified in the notice summoning such Meeting.

27°. The foregoing shall be printed and distributed to each Member.
