THE GIRLS＇AUXILIARY
At the annual meeting of the Women＇s Auxiliary， held in St．James＇school house in May last，the banner of the St．Alban＇s Branch of the Girls＇Auxiliary called forth a great deal of criticism．Truly it was a shabby article，and did present a sorry appearance in com－ parison with the artistic productions of the twenty－ seven other brancbes．Now our girls do not intend that such a state of things shall continue，and are deter－ mined that at next year＇s annual meeting the St． Alban＇s banner shall be the most conspicuously beau－ tiful of all in the room．With this end in view they will hold a concert in the crypt on Thursday evening，Nov．15th，at $8 \mathbf{p . m} .$, to raise funds to purchase the necessary materials for a new banner． A member of the congregation has kindly offered to design a banner，and one of the members of the Auxiliary will make it up．

The girls of the Auxiliary therefore earnestly ask and trust that the members of the congregation will show their interest and sympathy in the work of the Auxiliary and its present little undertaking by being present at the concert on Thursday，Noy．15th，when a programme of songs，readings，violin and banjo playing，etc．，will be presented．

Tickets are ten cents each，and may be obtained from any member of the Girls＇Auxiliary，or at the door on the night of the concert．

## CATHEDRAL HERALDRY

The foregoing suggests a few remarks on heraldic matters from a cathedral point of view．The design for a new banner，which with slight appropriate changes may serve as a general design for any of the organizations formed in connection with St．Alban＇s， is an adaptation from a device printed in the＂Boke of Saint Alban＇s＂in 1486 ．It is a remarkable coincidence， which was wholly undesigned when the name of St． Alban＇s was selected for the Cathedral of this Diocese， that the armorials of the Diocese granted in 1839 consist in their principal feature of a St．Alban＇s cross，com－ posed of a golden crozier and key disposed in＂saltire＂ on a blue ground．The St．Alban＇s cross is a golden ＂saltire＂on a blue ground．This is also the principal feature of the arms of the new Diocese of St．Alban＇s in England
It is to be regretted that the design for the enamelled badge used by the school was not shown to someone with a little knowledge of heraldry before the badges were made，for it is a contravention of one of the first rules of heraldry．
