

The *Speaker* resumed the chair.

Report of the committee.

The chairman reported that the committee had gone into the consideration of the said bill and had directed him to report a progress therein and request leave to sit again.

And that the committee had come to the following resolutions.

Resolve.

“ *Resolved*, That it be recommended to the House to grant to the counties of *Queen's* and *Northumberland* the usual assistance in building Goals and Court-Houses whenever such buildings shall be begun in those counties.

Resolve.

“ *Resolved*, That it is the opinion of this committee that commissioners be appointed by the House to prepare and report at the next session a plan and estimate of the expence of proper buildings for the accommodation of the *General Assembly* and the Courts of Justice and that the sum of £ 100 be granted to the said commissioners to purchase such boards and plank therefor as may require seasoning before they are wrought up.”

*Ordered*, That the said report be accepted.

Committee appointed.

And that the Honorable *George Duncan Ludlow* and *John Saunders*, Esquires, *James Glenie*, *Daniel Murray* and *Daniel Eymann*, Esquires, be and they are hereby appointed commissioners to prepare a plan and estimate of the expence of proper buildings for the accommodation of the *General Assembly* and Courts of Justice at such place as His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor shall point out; And that the said sum of £ 100 be paid by the Treasurer of the province to the said commissioners out of any monies hereafter to be received into the Treasury by warrant from the Lieutenant Governor or Commander in Chief for the time being with the advice and consent of His Majesty's Council, which warrant His Excellency is hereby requested to issue for that purpose.
